Statement of the Problem



- Clearly articulate the core research problem
- Describe the gap or issue in practice/society/knowledge
- Explain why this problem warrants research attention
- State what remains unknown or under-explored

- Identify what the existing literature has missed or overlooked
- Highlight contradictions or inconsistencies in prior studies
- Explain the specific gap this study addresses
- Justify the novelty and contribution of the research

- Present key results clearly and concisely
- Use tables, figures, or charts where appropriate

- Discuss alignment or contradiction with existing literature
- Explain practical and theoretical implications
- Reflect on unexpected or notable results
